For players registered for the 2023/2024 season, Permission to Play forms are valid until October 1, 2023.

No player may participate in any PWSA sanctioned activity with a team other than their own team unless they have a release or properly executed Permission to Play form.

A player who is under suspension is NOT eligible for Permission to Play unless they have prior written approval from the PWSA Discipline Board.

PWSA Player Movement / Tryout Policy

"Permission to Play" forms must be filled out and signed by a designated executive member of the player's current association/team and presented to the association/team for which the player wishes to try out before she is allowed on the field. Failure to comply will result in a minimum of 2 months' suspension for the offending player and/or head coach.
